OBJECTIVES : The first year* of the master's degree in « International and European Law » is a French national degree, taught in English, fully recognized in Europe and complying with the Bologna process. This one-year program equals 60 credits in the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS).

The MIEL aims at giving students a thorough knowledge of the private and public aspects of international and European legal issues.

The programme offers a comparative perspective, focuses on methodology with a view to providing the students with the tools needed to hold positions as lawyers in an international and European context.

A study trip to Brussels is organised for students to discover the European Institutions.

* In the French system, the master's programme is divided into two years: Master 1 (first year) and Master 2 (second year).

At the end of the degree, students who pass the exams acquire 60 ECTS credits and are entitled to apply for the second year of the Master's degree in France.

In particular, the MIEL gives the opportunity to apply for the second year of one of the Master's degree programs taught in English (or both in English or French) at Toulouse 1 Capitole University, in the following areas of study:

- → Comparative International Law,
- → International Economic Law,
- Private International Law.

SKILLS AND TARGETED OCCUPATIONS

SKILLS:

Occupational integration preparation, legal document drafting, plea and counselling simulations.

TARGETED OCCUPATIONS:

You may read the OFIP's surveys about occupational integration of the graduate student:

The OFIP (Observatoire des Formations et de l'Insertion professionnelle) surveys the academic and professional future of the alumni after 30 months – continuation or resumption of studies, occupational integration, occupation characteristics (sector, status, functions, professions, wages, geographical mobility).

ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

TARGETED PUBLIC:

A three-year degree in law is required, equivalent to 180 ECTS (European credits) i.e. Bachelor's degree, Licence or equivalent.

Other qualifications and area of study may be considered by the Admission Committee. Students must have an adequate command of the English language to enrol. An applicant's English proficiency level may be demonstrated by means of score reports of recognized exams, tests or certificates (equivalent to C1 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) or by any relevant means (study and life experience in a program taught in English...).

Selection criteria

The admission committee will assess your application based on academic results, English proficiency, personal experience (international and/or professional) and motivation.

All the candidates have to submit a specific application. The procedure for application will be specified on UT1 or European School of Law website (http://esl.ut-capitole.fr/).

Registration fees: 3000 €, no matter the applicant's nationality.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

The course lasts 9 months (1st Semester from September to December and 2nd Semester from January to May) for a total of 408,5 hours.
